Cedar's School Uniform

Last year we experienced difficulties with our regular supplier of school uniform. We have subsequently changed to a new online supplier - Signature Works. Our new uniform with a new logo is now available to purchase online. The new uniform will be gradually phased in and so all children are very welcome to keep wearing the current uniform for the remainder of their time at Cedar. We have some residual stock of uniform with the older logo and it is available to purchase at school until the stock runs out. Sweatshirts @£9:00, Polo shirts @ £7:00, P.E T-Shirts @ £6:00. We also have sample sizes of the new uniform to assist with ordering the new uniform online. Signature Works provide excellent quality garments and are slightly more expensive e.g. polo shirts @ £8:50 and sweatshirts at £11:50. Cedar will also receive 10% donation from any stock sold through Signature Works.

Annual Summer Reports and Exercise Books

Parents/carers are invited to collect their child(ren)'s exercise books, Annual Summer Reports and other belongings during the week beginning the 15th June. All your child's work will be organised in labelled plastic bags in alphabetical order by the child's surname and sorted into family groups.

If the weather is dry they will be arranged on the footpath to be collected. If the weather is wet, please come to the side door of the school hall. Please observe social distancing at all times and queue 2 metres apart.

If the allocated day does not suit, please come on Friday 19th June 2020.
