

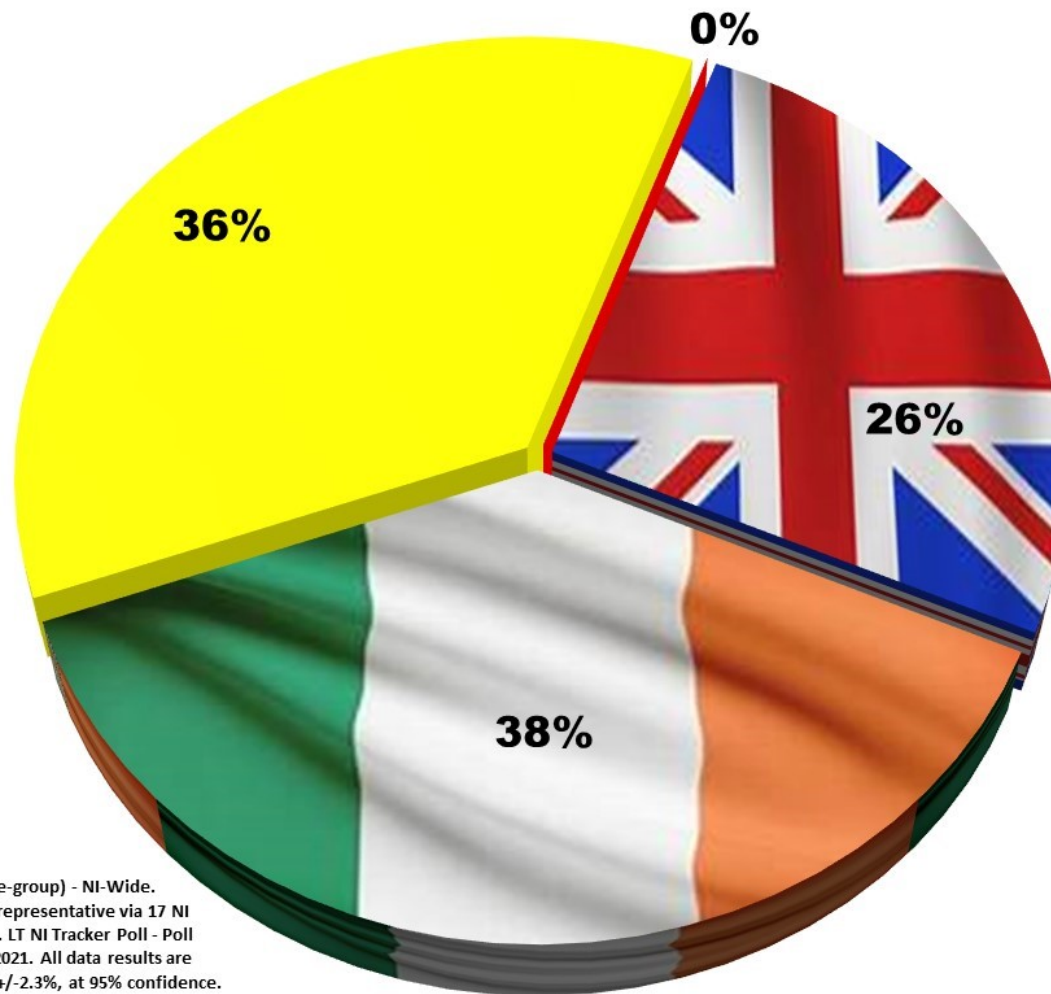


LUCIDTALK NORTHERN IRELAND(NI) SUNDAY TIMES Poll-Project: January 2021
